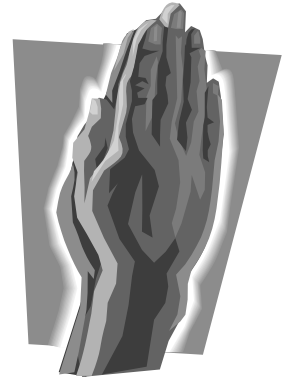

Insurance Matters . . .
