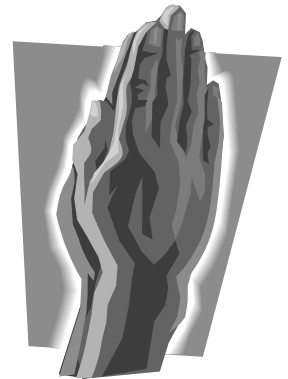

## *Pull tabs for Indian summer camp*

This year, Ascension, St. Agnes, St. Gabriel, Nativity School and St. Patrick's will join for the Knights of Columbus sponsored pull-tab competition. All proceeds benefit the children of Indian Summer Camp (ISC). The Knights will present the coveted pull-tab trophy at the end of the school year to the school that collects the most tabs per student.

ISC is a camp for children with cancer. The camp offers children ages 6-17 the chance to get away and just have a good time. The children can meet others who understand what they are going through, so they realize that they are not alone. They make friends, laugh and learn how to be a kid again. The camp offers activities not easily provided at home or in medical institutions.

All funds for the camp are either donated or collected through fund raisers. There are no

paid staff members. All counselors, physicians and nurses volunteer their time for the work. ISC uses aluminum pull-tabs as a fund raising mechanism. Last year over 1,100 lbs of pull-tabs were collected. This summer, we donated \$600 to the camp and a child was able to attend camp for free.

Together, we can make a difference in a **child's life.**
