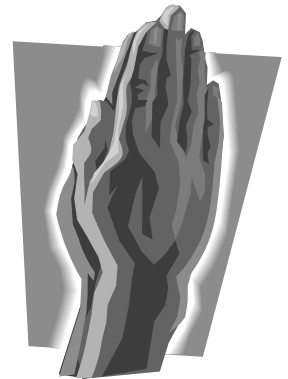

Track & Field (Area 4 Spring Games)

Track & Field is the largest sport for Special Olympics Kentucky! There are currently over 1,300 athletes that participate in this sport statewide and the number continues to grow. The SOKY Track & Field Area 4 Spring games will be Saturday May 9th at Fairdale High School. There are 9 Area Track & Field competitions and these events serve as qualifying events. An athlete must participate in an Area-level competition in order to qualify for the State Games held the first weekend of June each year in Richmond at ECU.

These Area Track & Field competitions are very important because for many of the athletes it is their only Special Olympics competitive experience as not all athletes can make the State Games trip. For others, it is the competition that qualifies them for the next level. Therefore, it is important that these events are organized and well run. Our role in the Games has been venue directors for the softball throw, we register, stage, escort, run the competition and record the results for about 100 athletes each year, for the last 4 years, I hope you will consider joining us this year.
